

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
TOWN OF GREEN MOUNTAIN FALLS  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING – TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2012**

**The Board of Trustees meeting was called to order by Mayor Worthey at 7:04 p.m.**

Trustee Price requested to address the Board with his concerns about the live streaming of this meeting. Price stated that he had emailed his concerns to Mayor Worthey and the board. While he is not opposed to live streaming as a communication tool, he is opposed to the fact that there are commercials interjected during the meeting stream. He felt this was inconsistent from the live streaming of the City of Colorado Springs and the County Commissioners meetings. He felt someone must be making money on the stream if commercials were being played. He stated stit was not a requirement of the Open Meetings Law. Price stated that the Board had not been informed that live streaming of the meetings was going to take place and he had no knowledge of who was doing the streaming. He requested that the streaming be discontinued until the commercials could be removed and the board members could discuss and agree on the use of live streaming. Price felt that the Board invited residents to meetings by posting agendas and minutes. In his opinion there was stronger citizen commitment in attending meetings. Trustee Pitrone stated that one live stream had been edited and the last six minutes of a meeting left out. Mayor Worthey stated that this is a public meeting and a citizen has chosen to live stream the meeting. She stated that the Town is not paying for it and the board cannot stop it because it is a citizen's prerogative. Trustee Stevens stated that the Board has no authority over a citizen live streaming the meetings.

**M/S Price/Pitrone to discontinue the live streaming until the commercials can be removed and the Board of Trustees approves live streaming the meetings.**

Mayor Worthey stated that there is nothing to vote on. Trustee Pitrone stated that there is a motion on the table and asked for a vote to be called. Worthey reiterated that the Board had nothing they could vote on.

Trustees Price, Pitrone and LoCascio left the council table. Due to a lack of a quorum, the meeting could not continue and adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
